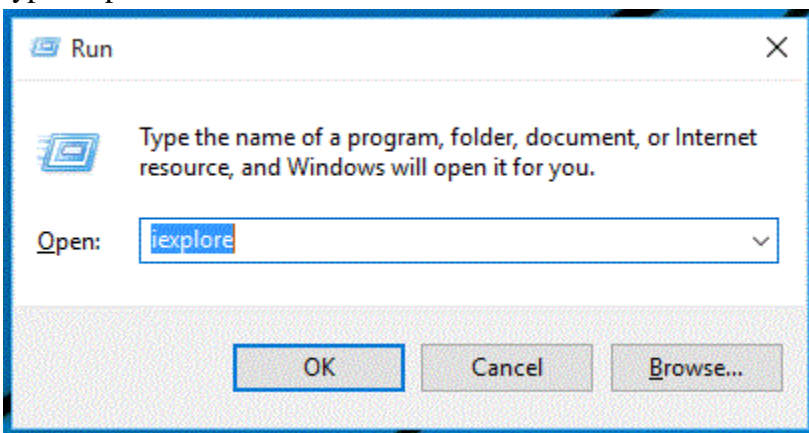


Using Traditional Internet Explorer after Upgrading to Windows 10

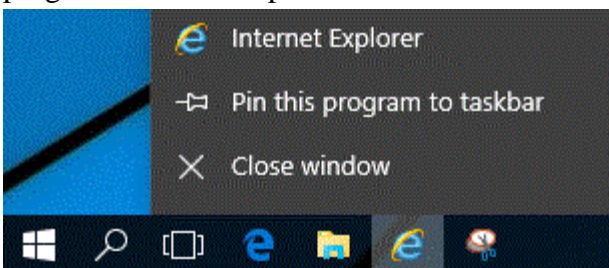
1. After an Upgrade or initial install of Windows 10 the only Icon available is for the new Microsoft Edge Browser, shown in image below with new blue 'e' icon.



2. On your keyboard hit the windows key + R in order to open up the run window. Then type iexplore in the run box and hit enter.



3. After Traditional Internet Explorer Opens you can then PIN that to the task bar for future use. Do this by right clicking the traditional blue "e" icon and then select the Pin this program to taskbar option.



4. You would then used the traditional blue Icon to open up the traditional Internet Explorer directly in the future.

NOTE: Java will still need to be installed. You should use the traditional Internet Explorer to initiate that install if it is not installed (your have a new install of Windows 10, rather than an upgrade on a machine you already had Java installed on)
